**YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)**

1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.193 dated 27.10.2024 registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC.

2. On 18.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

*Learned counsel representing the petitioner(s) submitted that although allegations have been levelled to the effect that the petitioner(s) had defrauded the complainant of an amount of about Rs.17 lakhs on the pretext of sending him abroad, but as a matter of fact the petitioner(s) who have been rendering consultancy services had done all the needful including all the paper work and a student visa was in fact successfully issued in favour of the complainant's brother who did go abroad and is still there on the basis of Visa which was got issued by the petitioner(s).*

*Learned counsel submitted that in any case without prejudice to their rights to contest the petitioner(s) can consider an amicable settlement for a lump sum amount of Rs.5 lakhs.*



*Notice of motion for 21.5.2025.*

*Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner(s) be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting / Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner(s) shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482 BNSS.*

*The petitioner(s) as per their offer shall deposit an amount of Rs.5 lakhs before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within a period of 2 weeks from today. Upon such amount being deposited, the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate shall get the same invested in some nationalized Bank in FDR with the specific direction to the Bank Manager concerned not to entertain any request for encashment except upon an order of the Court.*

*At this stage, Mr. Mayur Karkra, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed power of attorney in CRM-M-63766-2024. The same is taken on record.*

*The parties may consider resolving the matter amicably. A photocopy of this order be placed on the connected case.*

3. Today, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 18.12.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 18.12.2024 whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, she shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.

5. Disposed of.

6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
