1. Instant appeal has been preferred by the appellant seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.104 dated 08.11.2024 registered under Sections 120-B, 323, 354-A, 376(2)(n), 506 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of atrocities) Act, 1989 at Women Police Station Rewari, District Rewari and for setting aside the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari, vide which application of the appellant seeking anticipatory bail has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 29.01.2025 passed by this Court, the appellant has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Vinod Shankar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the
