**MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)**

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of an appropriate order or direction to respondents No.2 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 & 5 and take action on their representation dated 06.05.2024 (Annexure P-4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have recently filed a representation on 06.05.2024 before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala (Annexure P-4) raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior



Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 06.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of one month, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
