The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.94 dated 29.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 305/324(4) of BNS registered at Police Station IMT Rohtak, District Rohtak along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that there is ongoing dispute between the parties and they are living separately. Further, all the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and frivolous due to grudge and dispute between them.
