Application under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for correction of name of petitioner as 'Jashanpreet Singh' instead of 'Jashandeep Singh' in the index of accompanying petition.

For the reasons mentioned in application, the same is allowed. Name of petitioner be read as 'Jashanpreet Singh' instead of 'Jashandeep Singh'.

**CRM-M-31851-2025**

Petition under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 06.12.2024 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') (Sections 27 and 29 of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District ANTF SAS Nagar (Mohali), as wife of petitioner is on family way and there is nobody in the family to look after her.

2. Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that wife of petitioner has already given birth to a child on 06.06.2025.
3. Apart that 300 grams of *heroin* (commercial quantity) was allegedly recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant interim bail to the petitioner “at this stage”.
5. Consequently, petition is dismissed.
6. Needless to say that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
