1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, contempt proceedings are sought to be initiated against the respondents towards alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 12.12.2023 passed by this Court in LPA No.475 of 2022.
2. Learned State counsel representing the respondents submits that even the SLP preferred against the order dated 12.12.2023 stands rejected by the Hon'ble Apex Court and the process of release of benefits to the petitioners has already commenced and the needful shall be done within a week from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking made by the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.100,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
