1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.233 dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 384 & 120-B of IPC (Section 211 of IPC was added later on) at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner on the basis of compromise dated 14.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 03.12.2024, on written request circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner, case was adjourned for today. Today also no one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

3. On receipt of advance notice, Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and submits that there are total 04 accused in the present FIR and the instant

petition has been filed on behalf of only 01 accused and quashing of FIR on the basis of partial compromise is not maintainable in view of the law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in ***Rakesh Das Vs. State of Haryana : 2024(4) Law Herald 3141.***

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed at this stage. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars on behalf of all the accused involved in the present FIR.
