The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the memo dated 10.02.2020, Annexure P-8/II, whereby the petitioner, who was working as Guest Lecturer in Mathematics, was relieved from the Institute being surplus, to accommodate respondent no.5.

2. Learned senior counsel contends that during the pendency of the petition, the petitioner has been taken back in service as Guest Lecturer in the Government Polytechnic, Ambala, with effect from 09.11.2021. For no fault of her, she was kept out of service from 10.02.2020 to 09.11.2021, therefore, the period needs to be taken into account for giving continuity of service. Besides, as per the new enactment-the Haryana Contractual Employees (Security of Service) Act, 2024, she is entitled to remain in service upto fifty-eight years. At this stage, she may be permitted to make a fresh representation to the second respondent seeking continuity in service for the aforementioned period as well as protection in terms of the Act of 2024.



3. Learned State counsel contends that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the same will be decided by the second respondent/Director General, Technical Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months of receiving the representation.

4. In view of the statement made, learned senior counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
