1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends threat at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the State of Punjab submits that a complaint was received from respondent No. 6. However, after inquiry, the matter has been closed and no inquiry is pending with the police. He further submits that the petitioner shall not be harassed by the official respondents in any manner.
