Present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners in connection with FIR No.57 dated 20.04.2025, registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh, wherein the petitioners have requested for recovering the educational certificates of petitioner No.1 and other necessary documents belonging to petitioner No.2 from respondents No.3 to 5.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed representation dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2 raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. At this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Saumya Ahluwalia, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that she



has no objection in case the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage is allowed. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
