Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.131 dated 24.8.2024 registered under Sections 115, 118, 140(4), 190, 191(2) of BNS (Section 118(2) of BNS added later on) at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. On the last date of hearing, it was brought to the notice of the Court that no specific injury was attributed to the present petitioner who was stated to be empty handed at the time of the occurrence. It being so, this Court granted interim bail to the petitioner with direction to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made statement that in compliance of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.

4. State counsel on instructions from SI Harpreet Kaur has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.11.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
