Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.69 dated 17.03.2025 under Sections 115(2), 190, 191(2), 110, 351(3) of BNS (Section 117(2) of BNS added later on), registered at Police Station HSIIDC Barhi, District Sonapat.
