These are the applications under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of a sole Arbitrator to adjudicate upon the disputes and differences between the parties.

2. The parties are the same. The agreements are similar. Each of the agreements contains an arbitration clause. Disputes and differences have arisen between the parties. Though the arbitration clause requires the Arbitrator to be a fellow of Indian Institute of Architects/Engineers, the parties have requested for appointment of a retired Judge as the sole arbitrator.

3. The petitions are therefore disposed of by appointing Justice V.K.Jhanji, a retired Judge of this Court, # 1150, Sector 15-B, Chandigarh, as a sole arbitrator in respect of each of the matters. Separate awards shall be given. Whether common evidence ought to be taken or not will also be decided by the learned Arbitrator. The parties agree that the venue of arbitration shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
