**HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)**

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct respondent No.1 (Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana) to decide the revision petition bearing ROR No.269 of 2024 (Annexure P-4) titled as “*Tej Pal Singh and others Vs. Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad and others*”, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the aforesaid revision petition (ROR No.269 of 2024) has been filed before the Financial

Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana, on behalf of the petitioners, thereby challenging the partition proceedings. It is submitted that along with the said revision petition, petitioners have also filed a stay application. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the revision petition was filed in July, 2024, however till date, not even a single hearing has taken place in the same; and on the other hand, respondent No.5, by taking benefit of this situation, is trying to get the warrants of possession executed.

3. At this stage, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to her. She, on instructions from Mr. Kamal, Assistant to the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana, submits that the revision petition (ROR No.269 of 2024), along with the stay application, is now listed for hearing on 23.01.2025 before the learned Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana; however, due to some administrative exigencies, the Court is not being held on the said date (23.01.2025). She further submits that the next Court day is 06.02.2025 and in all probabilities, the aforesaid revision petition along with the stay application would be taken up for hearing on 06.02.2025 and be decided on the same day itself, and in any case, not beyond a period of two weeks thereafter. Learned State counsel further submits that the warrants of possession issued in the partition case would not be executed till the decision of the aforesaid stay application filed by the petitioners along with the revision petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners, keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition.

5. Ordered accordingly.
6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
