NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct free and fair investigation by taking appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 7 for committing the offence of gang rape, tress pass and threat to kill the petitioner and her family members.
2. Short reply by way of an affidavit of Inderjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Rajasansi, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, wherein it has been stated as under:-

“7.That it is humbly submitted that the representation dated 23.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner has been inquired into by the then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Attari, Amritsar(Rural) in a Professional manner in accordance with the standard procedures envisaged under the Punjab Police Rules, 1934 and Criminal Procedure Code without any prejudice,bias or ill-



will against any party. The allegations of the petitioner have been found to baseless and devoid of truth.

8. *That so far, as the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members and maintenance of law and order is concerned, the police authorities of the Amritsar (Rural) are committed and duty bound to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members by providing every possible help to them whenever required. The answering respondents undertake that necessary action will be immediately taken to ensure the safety of life and liberty of the petitioner after carrying out ground level assessment and if the need be, adequate security will be provided to them in accordance with the rules and procedure.”*

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other legal remedies available in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
