1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to ensure free, fair and impartial inquiry of the present case and to conduct thorough investigation on representation dated 01.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset submits that injuries suffered by the petitioner are simple in nature and from the allegations made by the petitioner, no cognizable offence is made out. However, proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C. have been initiated.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to invoke alternative remedies as available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
