The instant petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to submit status report before this Court in case FIR No.36 dated 27.05.2023, under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC, registration at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, Kapurthala.

02. Learned State counsel submits that status report in this case has already been filed on the last date of hearing. He while relying upon the contents of the status report dated 13.01.2025 submits that vide GD No.025 dated 04.01.2025 charges under Section 376 IPC and under Section 4 of POCSO Act have been added in the FIR as the victim was found to be minor. Respondent No.4 was taken into custody and after securing transit remand, the respondent was produced before the Illaqa Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi and sent to judicial custody on 01.01.2025. He further submits that daughter of the petitioner and the child were produced before the Child Welfare Committee, Kapurthala on 06.01.2025 and her statement was

recorded to the effect that she does not want to live with her parents and pursuant to which the victim as well as child were sent to Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar.

03. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed as the petition has become infructuous.

04. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

05. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
