Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.235 dated 30.11.2024 registered under Sections 22-B, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. The allegations in nutshell are that police recovered 18 grams of Heroin from co-accused Rajat and the FIR was registered against him. Rajat suffered disclosure statement against Usman. Present petitioner was nominated as accused on the basis of the disclosure statement suffered by said Usman.

3. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation as the instant case comes under non-commercial quantity of contraband and further, the petitioner was not named in the FIR and nominated as accused only on the basis of the disclosure statement suffered by co-accused.

4. Today, counsel appearing for the petitioner made statement that in compliance of previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and that the petitioner is having no criminal history.

5. State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kumar submits that the petitioner, who has joined investigation with the police, is no longer required for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

6. Apparently, this case appears to be relating to recovery of non-commercial quantity of contraband and thus, is not covered under stringent provisions of Section 37 of NDPS Act and further the petitioner who is having no criminal antecedents, is not required for purpose of further investigation by the police.

7. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 19.12.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
