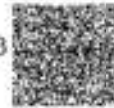

**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):**

Learned State Counsel has informed that in compliance of order passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, the prisoner namely Sandeep has already been examined by the Medical Board, and the Medico-Legal Report has been submitted in the Court in a sealed cover.

2. The prayer in the present petition are three folds:-

- (i). the production of prisoner before the Court. This prayer stand addressed in view of the report submitted by the respondent, wherein it has been mentioned that through video conferencing, in compliance of production warrant, the prisoner was produced before the Court;
- (ii). the medical examination of the prisoner. This prayer, too, stands addressed in view of statement made by learned State counsel;
- (iii). the initiation of action against respondents no.6 and 7 in view of



the contents of the petition.

3. Since a cognizable offence is made out with regard to alleged act of respondents No.6 and 7, the appropriate remedy available to the prisoner or the petitioner is to file a complaint before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate.

4. As a sequel to above observations, it is hereby held that any cause for the present petition does not survive. Hence, the same is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a complaint, if he desires so, in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate.
