2. On 26.05.2025, this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Shashi Kumar Garg, Assistant Registrar (Legal), Office of DSE (SE) Punjab SAS Nagar, has submitted that as far as COCP-1889-2025 is concerned, all the petitioners except petitioner no.4 have been promoted and with respect to petitioner no.4, a speaking order rejecting his claim would be passed by 27.05.2025. It is submitted that place of posting with respect to the petitioners who have been promoted will be finalized today itself and information regarding the same would be produced on the next date of hearing.

It is further submitted that as far as COCP-2161-2025 is concerned, all the petitioners except petitioner no.5 and 6 have been promoted and with respect to petitioner no.5 and 6, a speaking order rejecting their claims would be passed by 27.05.2025. It is submitted that place of posting with respect to the petitioners who have been promoted will be finalized today itself and information regarding the same would be produced on the next date of hearing.

It is further submitted that as far as COCP-2246-2025 is concerned, all the petitioners except petitioner no.2 and 4 have been promoted and with respect to petitioner no.2 and 4, a speaking order rejecting their claims would be passed by 27.05.2025. It is submitted that place of posting with respect to the petitioners who have been promoted will be finalized today itself and information regarding the same would be produced on the next date of hearing.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance of the orders passed by the learned Single Judge and the above-said order, the petitioners except those specifically mentioned in the above-said order have been granted promotion and have also been given place of posting. It is further submitted that the speaking order with respect to the petitioners who have not been promoted have also been passed and the said petitioners are not satisfied with the said orders rejecting their claims for promotion. It is further submitted that the present petitions be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioners to challenge the said speaking order. It is also submitted that some of the petitioners are also not satisfied with their place of posting and thus, liberty be granted to them also to challenge the said aspect, in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present contempt petitions are disposed of, with the liberty as sought.
