1. Leave, as prayed for, is grated.
2. Application is disposed of.

**Main case**

3. Harpreet Kaur and Parkash Singh, petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be of marriageable age. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 9. They apprehend danger from them and seek protection to their life and liberty. They have placed on record marriage photograph and Marriage Certificate, Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively, evidencing their marriage. They have submitted a representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.2.

4. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation, Annexure P-5, and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
