1. The appellant-wife assails the correctness of order passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, on 31.10.2022, while assessing the interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per month payable by the respondent to the appellant. The respondent, as per his affidavit, is earning Rs.81,000/- per month while working as Manager in Dr. Pritesh Institute, New Delhi. Though the respondent alleges that the appellant is providing coaching to Badminton players in various schools and, therefore, earning Rs.35,000/- to Rs.40,000/- per month, however, there is no cogent evidence.

2. The respondent despite receipt of notice, has not entered appearance in this appeal.

3. Keeping in view the facts of this case, this Court is of the considered view that the ends of justice will be met, if the order dated 31.10.2022 is modified and the appellant is held entitled to interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.20,000/- per month from the date of filing of the application till disposal of the divorce petition.

5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
