1. The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Court Act and under Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against respondent for violating the order dated 21.08.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by Division Bench of this court.

2. Pursuant to order dated 28.05.2025 passed by this court, status report by way of a compliance affidavit dated 12.07.2025 of Mr. Devendra Sharma, Estate Officer HSVP, Karnal, has been filed in Court today on behalf of respondent, which is taken on record. Copy of the same is supplied to the opposite counsel.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that in pursuance to order passed by the Division Bench dated 21.08.2013 (Annexure P-1), the respondent has passed a detailed order which has



been annexed as (Annexure R-3) along with the aforesaid compliance affidavit.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after going through the same, has submitted that in view of the compliance affidavit the present petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge the order Annexure R-3, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.

6. All pending applications, if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
