[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 04.04.2022 in CM No.707-LPA of 2022 in RA-LP No.31 of 2020 in LPA No.2230 of 2011 in case titled as 'Faquir Chand versus State of Haryana and another', that no further proceedings be taken by the contempt Court in COCP No.1494 of 2020, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of COCP No.1494 of 2020 on decision of the review application if the circumstances of the case so warrant.

[2] The same is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

[3] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 at this stage, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
