

money/expenses incurred upon changing of electric wire. Neither the private respondents were armed with the deadly weapons nor they caused any injury to the petitioner, as falsely alleged. It is further submitted that, on the basis of the complaints dated 03.06.2024 and 22.07.2024 moved by respondent No.6 (Lovejeet Kaur) daughter of Amarjit Singh, an FIR No.56 dated 10.08.2024 under Sections 354-A/506 of IPC, 1860 Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran has been registered against the petitioner. Thus, the petitioner can avail remedy available to him in pursuance to the FIR (supra) registered against him by the respondents.

4. Taking note of all these submissions, as has been penned down in the status report also, this Court is of the view that no cause continues to survive with the petitioner and therefore, the present petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy as available to him in accordance with law before an appropriate forum, if any, cause accrues to him in future.
