The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional honorarium of ₹10,000 per month to the petitioners with effect from the date of joining as per notification, dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-2.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from fourth respondent, vide memo dated 28.03.2025, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. He contends that all the petitioners had initially joined Nuh (Mewat) District in 2006 and 2007 as per details mentioned therein, and have been working there ever since. Accordingly, they are not entitled to additional honorarium in terms of notification dated 13.04.2022.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to dispute these facts.

4. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the petition and it stands dismissed *in limine*.
