1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.101 dated 30.06.2024, under Section(s) 324, 323, 326, 148, 149 of IPC registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.
2. The injury attributed to the petitioner is by sword on the head of the complainant, which in fact, is the injury falling under Section 326 of the IPC. Even, the said injury was present at the time of conducting the medical legal examination.
3. Thus, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, present petition stands **dismissed**.
