The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioner the notional benefit of antedated promotion from the post of Clerk to Assistant, Deputy Superintendent and Superintendent with retrospective effect from the date of eligibility. Further, a direction has been sought to grant the benefit of three per cent horizontal reservation in promotion under the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995, and Haryana Government circular dated 11.07.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent no.2. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 04.11.2024, Annexure P-9, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 04.11.2024, will be decided by respondent no.2-Director,



Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
