1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 11.07.2022, in CWP-3008-2021.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1 reveals that grievance of the petitioner with regard to benefit of stepping up of pay extended to the petitioner vide order dated 10.05.2019 was not implemented and the writ petition was disposed of in the light of stand of learned counsel for the respondents that in case order dated 10.05.2019 was not implemented, the petitioner would be given show cause notice within one month from the date of order, failing which, the aforementioned order would be implemented/or on the decision of the show cause notice pursuant to receipt of the reply.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the respondent has communicated order dated 19.10.2022, to the petitioners, rejecting the claim of the petitioners for grant of benefit in

terms of order dated 10.05.2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but pray for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 19.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
