1. The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate and strict legal action against the respondents No.4 to 6 and on the representations dated 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representations filed by the petitioner raising her grievances which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Navreet Kaur Barnala, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the
