1. Present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 18.07.2025 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a perusal of the impugned order would show that the main appeal itself is listed for arguments on 22.09.2025. It is further submitted that counsel for the petitioner before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court would be ready to argue the matter on 22.09.2025 or any other date which the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court would direct the counsel to argue the same. It is stated that the petitioner would limit his prayer, at this stage, to a direction to the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate
