**SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)**

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 11.10.2021 passed in CRM-M-28927-2021.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 11.10.2021 is reproduced as under:-

*“Trial Court shall adjourn the case beyond the date fixed before this Court.”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite directions to the trial Court to adjourn the case beyond the date fixed by this Court, the trial Court vide order dated 22.10.2024 decided the case.

Per contra, learned counsel for respondent contends that CRM-M-28927-2021 is withdrawn by the petitioner.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the file of this case with their able assistance.



5. A perusal of order dated 10.02.2025 shows that learned counsel for the petitioner withdrew CRM-M-28927-2021 by stating that the case has finally been disposed of by the trial Court. CRM-M-28927-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn having been rendered infructuous.

6. Since, order dated 11.10.2021 was passed in CRM-M-28927-2021 and the same was withdrawn by the petitioner on 10.02.2025, therefore, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
