1. By way of present petition the petitioner has challenged the summoning order dated 19.10.2022 vide which the petitioner has been summoned to face trial in a complaint instituted by respondent No.2, subsequent committal of the case to the Court of Sessions for trial.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one application for discharge has been moved by the petitioner, which is pending consideration and a direction be issued to the trial Court to decide the application before the charges are framed.
3. In view of this contention raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition in hand is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to decide the application moved by the petitioner for discharge before the charges are framed.
4. The petition in hand is disposed of accordingly.
