1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2 (b) read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 21.12.2023 passed in CWP-29136-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
