The present Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the learned Additional District Judge, Patiala, for expeditious and time bound adjudication of the application filed by the petitioner under Section 36(2) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 12.08.2025, a status report was called from the concerned Additional District Judge. In pursuance thereof, status report dated 29.09.2025 has been received from the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Patiala, wherein it has been so stated that the application under Section 36(2) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, has already been disposed of on 17.09.2025.
