The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.113, dated 05.11.2024, under Sections 109, 115(2), 352, 351(2), 191(3), 190, 118 of B.N.S, registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala, (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
