Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-4595 of 2016 titled as “B.S. Dhillon vs. State of Haryana and another” vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents “...to implement order dated 30.1.2007 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Agricultural Department in



*letters and spirit within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioner be also given a liberty to file a appropriate representation before the respondents for payment of interest for not releasing the arrears of salary by the respondent-Board for the last 14 years. Ordered accordingly.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition as necessary compliance has been made by the respondents vide order dated 19.7.2023 (Annexure R-1) whereupon arrears due to the petitioner have been released to him alongwith interest thereupon. It is, however, submitted that the complete arrears due to the petitioner have not been released. Accordingly learned counsel prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy available to him, as per law.

**Dismissed as withdrawn** with the liberty aforesaid.

Rule stands discharged.
