Short reply dated 09.12.2024 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, PBI, Homicide and Forensic, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, already filed in the Registry is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 23.10.2024 .

4. Learned State counsel intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. During the course of hearing on 23.10.2024 , following order was passed:

*“ Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that it is alleged that the petitioner alongwith other co-accused had caused injuries with baseball bat and sickle to the complainant. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and he has no criminal antecedents.*

*Notice of motion.*

*At asking of the Court, Mr. Vinay Kumar, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.*

*List on 11.12.2024.*

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer to join investigation within one week or as and when required. In the event of his arrest, the Investigating/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on interim bail on furnishing personal/surety bonds to his satisfaction. He shall abide by the following conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 :-*

*1) That the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required to do so.*

*2) That the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts to the Court or to any police officer.*

*3) That the petitioner shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court. ”*

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
