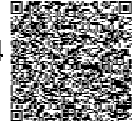
**KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)**

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to take the original file of all documents and issue the Registration certificate of Pharmacist to the petitioner as the file of the petitioner has not been taken by respondent No.2 since December, 2024.

2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has applied through online portal, however, he also wants to submit hard copy of his application in original.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only, at this stage.

4. Mr. Gopal Sharma, Advocate, has caused appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1, and waives service. He submits that the respondent No.1-Council has no objection in accepting the hard copy of application of the petitioner along with documents.



5. At this juncture, without deciding the instant *lis* on merits, and without making opinion regarding the eligibility of the petitioner to get registration certificate from the Haryana State Pharmacy Council, this Court deems it appropriate to pass a mandamus upon respondent No.1, to take a decision on the application (supra), so preferred by the present petitioner.

6. The petitioner is at liberty to submit the hard copy of the application (supra), with the authority concerned, within 07 days from today.

7. **Disposed of** accordingly.
