1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action on the representation of the petitioner dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) against respondents No.5 to 8.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) before the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation on the merits of the case within a stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 4 only.



4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and waives service.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction for deciding the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-5) on the merits of the case be given to the respondent No.2 and that the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass a speaking order and decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-5) on the merits of the case within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. However, it is hereby clarified that no opinion with regard to merits of the case is being rendered and the police authorities shall be at liberty to take any decision, uninfluenced by the contents of this order.
