1.               Present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, praying for quashing of case/FIR no.36 dated 19.02.2020 under sections 419, 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station- 36, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising there-from *qua* the petitioners, in view of the Compromise Deed Dated 03.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2.               Status report dated 20.02.2025 filed by the State counsel, and the same is taken on record.

Learned A.P.P., U.T. Chandigarh, informs that the petitioners herein are involved in the crime of cyber fraud, and with great difficulties, such accused are identified, and because of committal of such offences, psycho fear develops against general public also. Therefore, no compromise quashing petition should be permitted in general.

3.               Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

4.               Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
