PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

The claimant is in appeal. The claimant suffered injuries in a motor vehicular accident dated 19.11.2015. She approached MACT, Karnal by way of MACT Case NO.8 of 2016 under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. The Tribunal awarded her compensation of ₹ 45,000/-.

2. The claimant suffered injuries of intense magnitude and gravity on her left leg. She remained hospitalized from 21.11.2015 till 25.11.2015. The Tribunal awarded a sum of ₹ 10,000/- on account of medical expenses on actual basis. ₹ 5000/- was awarded to her for transportation etc. ₹ 10,000/- has been awarded for incidental expenses. ₹ 10,000/- has been awarded for special diet and ₹ 10,000/- for pain and suffering.

3. Counsel for the appellant submits that nothing has been awarded for future medical expenses, loss of income and for loss of marriage prospects.

4. In the considered opinion of this Court, nothing has been shown on record as to how the appellant suffered loss of marriage prospects. There is no evidence regarding future medical expenses. Having said that, this Court finds that compensation awarded by the Tribunal under various heads need to be re-worked.

5. The medical expenses being granted on actual basis is maintained. For transportation, the claimant is held entitled for ₹ 10,000/-. ₹ 10,000/- awarded on account of incidental expenses is also ordered to be maintained. Nothing has been awarded for attendant charges. The claimant is held entitled for a sum of ₹ 20,000/- as attendant charges and ₹ 20,000/- for special diet. For pain and suffering also, the claimant is held entitled for ₹ 50,000/-. Another sum of ₹ 10,000/- is awarded for loss of income for the period the claimant remained hospitalized and on bed.

6. Disposed off accordingly.
