VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 17.03.2025 vide which the conditional warrants of arrest with police help against the petitioner have been issued.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the conditional warrants of arrest are in violation of law and thus, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the Executing Court.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the maintainability or otherwise, or on the merits of any such application which the petitioner proposes to file and in case any such application is filed, the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
