Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.285 dated 10.9.2024 registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 333, 334(1), 351(3), 329(4), 309(4), 61(2) of BNS at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram.

2. On the last date of hearing, it was brought to the notice of this Court that there are no specific allegations appearing on record against the present petitioner. Further, the petitioner was having nothing to do with the shop in question which is owned by his cousin brother who is having civil litigation with regard to shop in question with complainant Krishan. In view of above, the petitioner was directed to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that by virtue of the order dated 11.12.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.
