**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

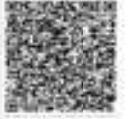
Mr. Ashish Aggarwal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

On 16.05.2025, the following order was passed:-

*“Petitioner, through the instant petition (second), is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.343 dated 11.12.2021 under Sections 307, 34, 302, 108, 111, 112, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 25 and 27 of The Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Division B, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. to face trial as an additional accused, therefore, there is a genuine apprehension on his part that he could be arrested and sent to custody when he appears before the trial Court.*

*Copy of order passed by the trial Court be produced on or before the next date of hearing.”*

In deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
