1. Present Contempt Petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating and not complying with the order dated 17.02.2025 (Annexure P-1)
