SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Petitioner, before this Court, is raising essentially an environmental issue by contending that respondents No. 7 to 9 are indulging in the process of manufacturing activities causing pollution without permission/licensing and requisite no objection certificate.

2. It is contended that respondent No. 6/Gill Seat Industry situated within the Bhadaur Tehsil Tapa, District Barnala, is causing nuisance by polluting the area in its vicinity including the residential area. The petitioner has made representations dated 24.06.2025 (Annexue P-4) to the Punjab Pollution Control Board, Barnala/respondent No.3 and the other dated 11.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) moved to SDM, Tapa, District Barnala.



3. This Court deems it appropriate that the said representations be disposed of before the process of adjudication is embarked upon.

4. Accordingly, the petition (CWP-PIL-288-2025), without commenting on merits, is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 3 and 5 to decide the aforesaid representations dated 24.06.2025 and 11.07.2025 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), respectively, by passing a speaking order within a period of sixty days.
