SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. This case pertains to the year 200 and falls in the category of old cases.
2. On 04.04.2025, Registry was directed to issue notice to the appellant as well as his counsel for the date fixed. As per office report, notice issued to the appellant received back with the report that he has died and his counsel Mr. R.D. Bawa, Advocate has been informed through e mail.
