Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-25435-2024 titled as “Jaswinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and another”, vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents to the effect that “...in case the legal notice dated 27.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of



*certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.....”.*

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed the Compliance Affidavit dated 12.8.2025 of Shri Rajiv Kumar Gupta, Director State Transport, Punjab and submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing an Order dated 20.6.2025 by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Compliance Affidavit dated 12.8.2025 is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
