In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for counting of the qualifying service of the petitioner for grant of pensionary benefits. A reliance has been made in the light of judgment passed in CWP No.8285 of 2004 titled as Ved Parkash v. State of Punjab and Ors. decided on 16.09.2010.
